

SLOPPY JOES

What you need

Pack of buns of your choosing

1 pound of lean ground beef

1/4 cup of chopped onion 1/4 cup of chopped green

bell pepper 1/2 teaspoon of garlic

1 teaspoon of prepared yellow mustard

3/4 cup of ketchup

3 teaspoons of brown sugar

A pinch of salt and pepper

In a medium skillet over medium heat, brown the ground beef, onion, and green pepper; drain off liquids.

Stir in the garlic powder, mustard, ketchup, and brown sugar, then mix thoroughly.

Reduce heat, and simmer for 30 minutes. Scoop onto buns, season with salt and pepper, and serve.
