# Pool Reminders Safety is our First Priority

Summer is finally here! This means are beautiful pools are being used daily and we need your help! Parents, please remember to supervise your children at all times. We don't want a day of fun to be ruined with any injuries, especially when they are avoidable. Safety is always our first priority. Keep your child from running on the pool deck, diving into the pools, or participating in any other activity that could cause injuries.

- All Patrons and guest(s) swim at your own risk. There are no lifeguards on duty at any time at the pool facilities.
- At any given time, an adult Patron may accompany up to four (4) guests per household, unless otherwise approved.
- Children 13 years of age and younger must be accompanied by an adult or a supervisor/babysitter at least 18 years of age at all times while using the pool facilities.
- Children 14 or older should be prepared to provide proof of age when visiting pool unaccompanied by adult.
- A Parent or Supervisor must be within arm's length of a non-swimmer at all times when in the water, regardless of the type of floatation device used.
- Glass, other breakable or sharp, potentially hazardous objects are prohibited in the Pool Area.
- Children under three (3) years of age, and those who are not reliably toilet trained, must wear appropriate swim-diapers, as well as a swimsuit over the swim-diaper, to reduce the health risks associated with human waste in the Swimming Pool.
- Play equipment such as small floats, pool noodles, kick boards, water wings, dive sticks, snorkels, and infant safety floatation devices must meet with the Amenity Center Staff approval. The Amenity Center reserves the right to prohibit use of any play equipment especially during peak times or scheduled activities at the pool or if the equipment proves a safety concern or nuisance.
- Proper swim attire must be worn in the Pool Area at all times. Cut-offs, denim, thongs, Brazilians, cheekys are not allowed.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in the Pool Area.
- Smoking (including e-vapor cigarettes) and all tobacco products (including chewing tobacco) is not permitted anywhere in the Amenity Centers.
- No diving, jumping, pushing, running, or other horseplay is allowed in the pool or on the pool deck, including swinging on ladders, fences, or railings.
- For the comfort of others, the changing of diapers or clothes is not allowed in the Pool Area.
- Loud, profane, or abusive language is prohibited.
- In accordance with Health Department Rule 64E-9.004, there is to be no food or drink within four (4) feet of the pool.



#### CDD vs. POA - What's the difference?

Johns Creek, like so many neighborhoods in Florida, has both a CDD (Community Development District) and a POA (Property Owners Association). Who should be contacted about changing a house color? Who is responsible for the pools? Hopefully, this will help clarify the difference:

A POA governs the community to make sure the community remains fiscally healthy, that the homes within the community are adhering to the deed restrictions. They have their own budget, board of directors, and property manager (company) separate from the CDD. Within Johns Creek, we have both a POA for phase 1 and a POA for phase 2. These POA boards oversee several committees such as Social Committee, Neighborhood Watch Committee, and the Architectural Review Board. POA dues are paid annually, directly to the management company representing your POA.

The CDD is a governmental entity originally set up by the developer. Through medium-to-long-term municipal bonds, it serves the community by planning, financing and building, operating and maintaining specific infrastructures and amenities for residents. For instance, those funds may be used to put in water, sewer, electrical infrastructures, pools, tennis courts, clubhouses, common area landscaping, and pool maintenance, among others. The CDD also has an elected Board of Directors responsible for their own budget, management organization, common areas and amenities. CDD fees are paid as a non-ad-valorem tax that is included in your annual tax bill.
