Blood Drive

Saturday, February 15 9am-12:30pm Phase 1



Our bi-monthly Blood Drive is rapidly approaching. We were thrilled to reach over our goal in December and are hoping to keep that trend going. We are setting a goal of at least 7 donors.

All donors will receive a \$20 eGift card and a longsleeved t-shirt. You will also receive a wellness checkup that includes blood pressure, temperature, iron count, pulse and cholesterol screening.

You will need to bring an ID with you in order to donate. They prefer to have pre-registration, but it is not required. Walk-ins are always welcome if they have enough time and space.

How much does your donation help?

A single hospital patient can require a large amount of blood in a single situation.

- Cancer patients up to 8 platelet units per week
 - Burn victims up to 20 plasma units
- Car accidents up to 50 red blood cell units
- Heart surgery up to 6 red blood cell units and 6 platelet units
- Organ transplants up to 25 plasma units and 30 platelet units and 40 red blood cell units
- Premature infants up to 5 units of red blood cells

More Interesting Facts

- There is no substitution for human blood.
- 1 in 7 people entering a hospital need blood.
- One unit of blood can be separated into several components: red blood cells, plasma and platelets.
- Someone needs blood every two seconds.
- Less than 10% of the eligible U.S. population (38%) donates annually.

February is Black History Month. Here are just a few facts that you can share with your friends and family.

- Carter G. Woods is the "Father of Black History." The historian was the 2nd Black student to graduate from Harvard University with a doctorate degree. His incredible research led to the establishment of Black History Month in 1926. It later became a nationally recognized annual event in 1976,
- Black History Month is in February in recognition of the birthdays of Abraham Lincoln and Frederick Douglass. During the Civil War, Lincoln worked tirelessly to expand the rights of Black Americans. Frederick Douglass, a formerly enslaved man, became a leader who fought to end slavery during the abolitionist movement.
- The first published Black author was published in 1853. William Wells Brown wrote "Clotel: or, The President's Daughter". He was a lecturer and abolitionist.
- Claudette Colvin was the first Black woman known to refuse to give up her seat on a bus. While Rosa Parks is often given credit for being the first Black woman to refuse to give up her seat on a bus, Claudette Colvin was actually arrested nine months earlier for refusing to give up her seat for white passengers.
- Lucy Stanton was the first Black woman to earn a four-year college degree. Stanton earned a literary degree from Oberlin College in 1850.
- Nat King Cole was the first Black American to host a television show. The beloved jazz pianist and singer hosted The Nat King Cole Show on NBC in 1956.
- Hattie McDaniel was the first Black person to win an Oscar in 1940. She won for her supporting role in Gone with the Wind.


